2015 marks the 300th anniversary of the death of the 'Sun King', Louis XIV (r.1643 – 1715) and the accession of his grandson Louis XV (r.1715 – 1774). These two long-lived-monarchs were contrasting characters and their respective reigns forged very different paths for France. The former stabilized the country after a long period of religious strife and saw a golden age of French culture; the latter overseeing the rise of the decorative rococo style, but also a gradual decline in the prestige of the monarchy, which ultimately led to the French Revolution. This concert explores the music from the reigns of both monarchs, with music by Dieupart, Elisabeth Jacquet de la Guerre (whose 350th anniversary we celebrate this year), Leclair, Mondonville and Corrette.
