Distinguished harpsichordist and teacher Yeo Yat-Soon studied at King's College London and the Guildhall School of Music and Drama, where he was winner of the prestigious Raymond Russell Prize for Harpsichord. He performs widely in the UK, throughout Europe and the Far East as a soloist, chamber musician and a conductor of baroque opera. Projects for 2016 include the *Memento Mori Froberger*, a series in historic venues marking the 400th anniversary of the composer's birth and conducting Monteverdi's *L'Incoronazione di Poppea* for *Opéra de Baugé*. He has performed on BBC Radio 3, BBC 4 and Classic FM, and has had a long association with education having been Director of Music at The Lady Eleanor School and St Paul's Girls' School.
